Surf allows every individual the right to free speech and demonstration of their views, beliefs, and opinions, as long as it preserves the safety of our users. We will not take down content under the guise of misinformation as we do not possess the resources or the right to independently fact-check and to tell our users what to believe. Every Surf user is expected to independently research and identify the truths behind what they see. As long as the content is appropriate, it will be allowed on our platform. The following forms of content are prohibited on all Surf platforms:

- Not Safe For Work [NSFW]: Any content containing nudity or display of sexual content is not allowed.
- Serious threats of death, bodily harm, or violent attacks against individuals or/and the public.
- Blackmail, Doxxing, or the posting of one's information without their consent is prohibited and can warrant legal action.
- Spam and flooding are prohibited. Repeated posting of the same content or text is prohibited.
- Promotion of harmful or dangerous substances. This includes drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or any illegal goods respective to the individual's country of residence.
- harassment, tempestuous and tumultuous disrespect, and bullying
- Repeatedly contacting people for commercial purposes without their consent
- Content that engages in, promotes, encourages, facilitates, or admits to the offering, solicitation, or trade of fake and misleading user reviews or ratings.
- Spam advertising, and any Major scale advertising, unless authorised by Surf Administrators.
- Any legitimate/sincere encouragement of involvement with organised crime or terrorist organizations.

The posting of some of the above content will result in legal action and intervention. Any content in the "grey zone", in which the definition is somewhat met, will be up to Surf's moderators' interpretation.

We require all Surf members to participate per their local rules and regulations. We do not condone the breaking or violation of the law. However, we, as an organisation based in the United States, uphold every individual's right to freedom of speech, expression, and thought, regardless of nationality. We are committed to maintaining a free and stable community. However, inappropriate content or behaviour will face consequences. If any Surf member is caught violating any of these guidelines, please report them to the Surf Administration via the "Report" button in their user profile. Every Surf member is also responsible for maintaining the stability and security of this community. We expect our members to aid in the preservation of a diverse, respectful, moral, secure, and above all, free community.
